

LCM - Amtek Slope Stabilization Lexington, KY Project Date - date, 2011

Linden Long, Owner of LCM Company, has seen his share of steep slopes. He claims that the problem is only getting worse, due to the fact that people are trying to utilize every space that they can on increasingly smaller lot sizes. This dynamic is leading us to areas that are much more difficult to keep from eroding and to vegetate. That was the problem he was dealing with on a commercial building project in Lexington. The steep slope behind LCM's construction site was loosing soil over a retaining wall.

After consulting with him, EcoGro applied a seeded compost blanket to the area. A Filtrexx® LockDown<sup>M</sup> netting was used under the blanket to add sheer strength. We also added a compost Filtrexx® Channel Soxx<sup>M</sup> to a slope that received concentrated flows from an adjacent property. This unsightly hillside that was eroding onto the parking lot is now a green addition to the property.
